Applicants whose native language is not English or who have not earned a regionally accredited degree in the United States must also submit TOEFL scores earned within two (2) years of the desired term of entry. A minimum total score of 79 on the internet-based test, 213 on the computer-based test, or 550 on the paper-based test are required. Applications submitted with TOEFL scores that do not meet the minimum requirements will be denied with no exceptions.

The TOEFL requirement may be waived if the applicant meets one of the following conditions:

- Has scored 500 or higher on the GRE Verbal Test
- Has earned a college degree at a U.S. institution of higher learning
- Has earned a college degree from an institution whose language of instruction is English (must be noted on the transcript).

• Has scored 6.5 on [International English Language Testing System \(IELTS\)](#).

- GRE (General Exam) or MCAT Scores
 - Official GRE scores should be sent through ETS to Graduate Admissions (school code: R5828)
 - **MCAT SCORE SUBMISSION:** There is no place on the primary application for MCAT scores
 - Student AAMC ID number AND Verification codes located on the MCAT report will need to be emailed to graduate_education@grad.usf.edu
 - Indicate "MCAT Verification Code in the email subject area
 - In the email body include

 - Social security number
 - AAMC ID number
 - Verification Code

- Typed Graduate Program Application 
- Completed Science GPA Calculator 
- Resume/Curriculum Vitae
 - Should include relevant experience, volunteer work, research, presentations, publications, coursework, awards etc.
- Personal Statement (1-2 pages) describing personal interests and goals
 - Statements used/intended for professional schools (i.e. Ph.D., MD, DDS, etc.) may be used
- 3 Recommendations (any combination of letters or evaluation forms 
 - Evaluation forms are not required if letters are available
 - Evaluation forms may be used **in lieu of** letters
 - Recommendations should come from faculty or other professional familiar with applicant's academic performance or professional potential
 - Letters of recommendation through an agency (i.e. Interfolio) may be used in lieu of evaluation forms
 - Previous letters intended for professional schools will be accepted
 - This office is **not** a part of USF medical school admissions and does not have access to previously submitted letters

- Unofficial GRE, PCAT or MCAT Test Scores
 - Although a score must be indicated on the program application, an actual paper copy of the score report is not mandatory
